Donated medical and relief supplies need to be sorted on a daily basis. Attention to detail and the ability to follow instructions are a must. Great for volunteers age 16+ for Relief Supplies and 18+ for Medical Supplies.

## ☐ Giving for Living

Every day we open our doors to registered non-profits to obtain our basic needs supplies. Volunteers help by sorting through our inventory to make them available to these agencies and others. Great for volunteers age 16+.

Giving Children Hope is often asked to host a table at a community fair. If you enjoy meeting new people and answering questions about GCHope, you can be trained as a Volunteer Ambassador to attend these events. Great for volunteers age 16+.

#### GCHope Volunteer Code of Conduct:

- 1. Be punctual and reliable. Notify the Front Office Administrator (one day in advance) if you are unavoidably delayed or unable to keep your schedule.
- 2. Our Dress Code: Be comfortable and modest! Volunteers must wear closed-toe shoes.
- 3. Be sure to **turn off or put on silent mode any cell phones** or mp3 players. Refrain from using cell phones until on a break or standing outside away from the work site.
- 4. Please refrain from obscene or offensive language or conversations while on the premises. Please be respectful of staff members focused on their work. No shouting or screaming is allowed in the work place.
- 5. Be aware as you walk around the area to avoid stationary or moving pallet jacks or forklifts.
- 6. Please inform your project leader before leaving or taking a break. Volunteers are welcome to use the lunch room. Clean up after yourself and wash your dishes before you leave.
- 7. Leave your work area clean for the following shift. Throw away any trash or recyclables in properly marked containers.
- 8. GCHope is not responsible for any personal items. Please limit personal items brought on campus or use our lockers to store them.
- 9. The use of alcohol and/or illicit drugs is strictly prohibited prior to or during the hours served at Giving Children Hope. If violated, you will be escorted off property. Please no smoking except in designated areas.
