

## Warehouse Worker/Forklift Operator

**Responsibilities:** The Warehouse Worker/Forklift Operator is responsible for assisting with general warehouse operations:

- Handling incoming donations and outgoing shipments, ensuring all inventory protocols and updates are followed
- Must be able to receive, sort, stock, move, stage, and load inventory
- Lifting and operating manual handling equipment (stand up forklift/ sit down forklift/ pallet jack)
- Responsible for making deliveries and pickups as scheduled with warehouse and operations department
- This position is required to load and/or unload the truck before and after pickups/deliveries, both on site and off site.
- Must be able to run volunteer groups and give basic training to volunteers
- Maintains the cleanliness of the facility

The Warehouse Worker/Forklift Operator works under the general supervision of the Warehouse Manager.

### Qualifications:

- Class C license and clean driving record are required.
- Prior driving experience with 26' box truck is required.
- Must have prior experience in shipping and receiving.
- Knowledge of Microsoft Word and Excel is required; QuickBooks experience is preferred.
- Forklift certification and experience with manual handling equipment (pallet jack, stand up forklift/ sit down forklift) is required.
- Must be able to work with large and diverse groups of people (volunteers and staff members).
- Ability to lift 50 lbs. on regular bases and work on feet for 8 hours.
- Must be able to pass background and drug tests.
- Dependable daily attendance and work output/ ability to work independently and safely.

Salary: \$12-\$14 per hour, depending on experience. Position is full time; organization hours are Monday-Friday, 8:00 am to 4:30 pm.
