**Responsibilities:** The Warehouse Worker is responsible for assisting with general warehouse operations:

- Handling incoming donations and outgoing shipments, ensuring all inventory protocols and updates are followed
- Must be able to receive, sort, stock, move, stage, and load inventory
- Lifting and operating manual handling equipment
- Responsible for making deliveries and pickups as scheduled with warehouse and operations department
- Maintains the cleanliness of the facility

The Warehouse Worker works under the general supervision of the Warehouse Manager.

### Qualifications

- Class C license and clean driving record are required.
- Experience with manual handling equipment (pallet jack, stand up forklift/ sit down forklift)
- Ability to lift up to 50 lbs on regular bases
- Must be able to pass background and drug tests.
- Dependable daily attendance and work output
